

## HILTON HALL COMMUNITY CENTRE - MAIN HALL SOFFIT REPAINT - AUGUST 2011

Work carried out by Heather Manser, Keith Jones and Debbie Cox. We took advantage of the 'Scaffolding' (erected for the new Timken Window replacement project) and utilised it to gain access to paint the Main Hall Soffit. This part of the building is protected from direct Sunlight and therefore, the woodwork is still in very good condition (even though it had not been painted for well over ten years). At least this part of our 'Repair Programme' has now been successfully completed (and two years ahead of our schedule of work).



This work was scheduled for the last year of our 'Five Year Schedule of Work' as proposed in our Plans to the City Council as part of our repair and refurbishment agreement. However, we took advantage of the good weather conditions and the scaffolding being in place, coupled with the fact that 'We' were available and on-site everyday during the six-week school holiday period, which enabled us to complete this work now (ahead of schedule). We are now working towards finding a 'Sponsor' to fund the Upper Facia Panels (above windows).
