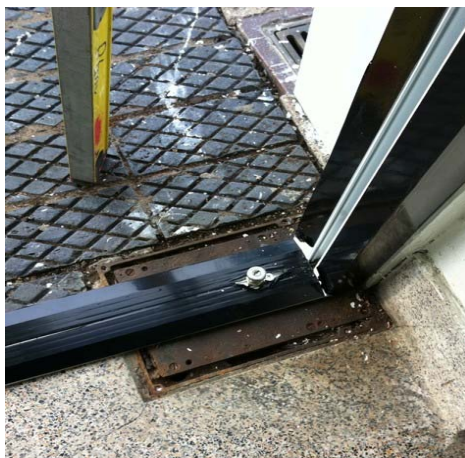
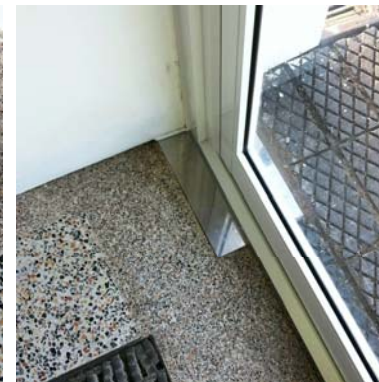


**HILTON HALL COMMUNITY CENTRE: THE FINAL STAGE OF OUR TIMKEN FOUNDATION TRUST FUNDED WINDOW & DOOR REPLACEMENT PROJECT
SUPPLIED AND FITTED BY SYSTEMS 2000 GROUP LTD. DECEMBER 6TH 2011**





This is the final stage of the Timken Foundation Funded – Window & Door Replacement Project 2011. The doors were supplied and fitted by Systems 2000 Group Ltd.

Their Engineers (Paul & Richard) worked hard all day removing the old dilapidated Front Entrance Doors, making good the entrance foot well / door threshold, and fitted our new Metal Framed Security Doors.

The Glass sections of these doors are made of 11.5mm 'Anti-Bandit' Laminated Glass and the Locking system has 'Five Locks' – one of them being a Digital Key Pad Lock.

An essential safety design feature of these doors is the integral child-proof safety hinge-protectors. This ensures that children and vulnerable adults cannot get their fingers caught in the Hinged-side of the Doors. The Doors are powder-coated with the correct shade of 'White' to match our new Window Frames and the whole effect is brilliant. We are well pleased with the work carried out and can highly recommend Systems 2000 Ltd.
